What is the AARP Tax Assistance Program?

The AARP Tax Assistance Program is a service by which trained AARP volunteers offer tax assistance and preparation help to taxpayers in Chippewa County.

Who can use the service?

Taxpayers who are in low and moderate-income tax brackets, persons filing Wisconsin Homestead Credit form returns and people 60 years of age and older are the target audience for the service.

The service is NOT available to persons filing under the status, "Married, filing separately."

How do I use the service?

Appointments will be made in person at the library with an AARP volunteer during the scheduled tax assistance times. Walk-ins are also welcome during scheduled times. See schedule on reverse.

Is there a charge for the service?

No, there is no charge for this service.

What should I bring to the appointment?

When you make your appointment, you will be given an *AARP Intake Sheet*. Fill out this form **before** you come for your appointment.

In addition to the completed form, you will need to bring copies of :

- Your 2008 tax return
- 2009 tax forms and preparation booklet
- W-2 forms from your employer
- All 1099 forms, including your Social Security Statement
- All of the applicable forms mentioned on the intake sheet
- Any other income, payment or tax-related documents which may apply to your tax return
- Social Security numbers of you, your spouse and your dependents
- Some form of identification

Your filing success depends on your advance preparation for the meeting with your tax assistance counselor.

Tax preparers reserve the right to refuse assistance if filing is too complex.

All sessions are held in the library's main floor meeting room.
